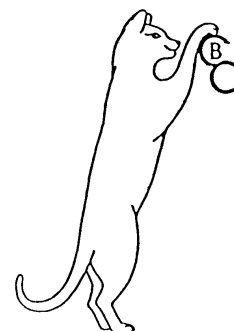
The Burmilla Cat Club was formed on 21st January 1984 with the object of promoting and establishing the BURMILLA breed. Affiliated to The Cat Association of Britain from July 1986 to November 2003, it is now associated with the independent club Everycat UK.

International Championship shows are held annually under Everycat UK Show Rules and the BCC MEWS is published twice a year.

The BURMILLA is an elegant cat of medium foreign type showing a striking contrast between its Silver undercoat and coloured Shading/Tipping, with delicate tracings of Tabby markings on the head, legs and tail. The coat is short and dense with a feel of raw silk at the tips. The eyes are any shade of green with dark pencilling on the lids. The nose is Terracotta, also with a dark outline. The Burmilla is extremely affectionate, intelligent and inquisitive – the ideal companion.

Varieties deriving from Burmilla breeding include the Golden Burmilla, the Tiffany also the Asian group: Smoke, Tabbies and Selves which may have short or long haired coats.
